District Wide Facility Analysis

School Summary Descriptions

Aldene Elementary School (K – 5th Grade)

Aldene School has 12 Classrooms - (2 per grade level) within the School.

1. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that a Kindergarten Classroom be 950 Square Feet including the attached toilet room for 21 students.

The (2) Kindergarten Classrooms exceed the recommended square footage.

2. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 1st thru 3rd Grade Classrooms be 850 Square Feet for 21 students.

The (2) 1st Grade Classrooms are 721 and 722 sf.

The (2) 2nd Grade Classrooms are 722 and 797 sf.

The (2) 3rd Grade Classrooms are 676 and 693 sf.

3. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 4th and 5th Grade Classrooms be 800 Square Feet for 23 students.

The (2) 4th Grade Classrooms are 733 and 792 Square Feet.

The (2) 5th Grade Classrooms are 725 and 757 Square Feet.

- Per the State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) One (1) additional classroom would be needed over the next five years to accommodate the increased 5th Grade student population.
- Art and Music are combined within one (1) 948 sf Classroom. An addition to the building would be required if the District would like to separate Art and Music.
- There is one Multi-Purpose Room serving three (3) functions – Gym, Auditorium and Cafeteria. The three (3) functions present a room setup hardship and there is no dedicated furniture storage room.
- A New Cafeteria, Kitchen and Kitchen Storage Room Addition would remove one function (And its associated furniture) from the Multi-Purpose Room. Also, the existing Kitchen can be then be repurposed into a Storage Room for the folding chairs that are needed for when the Multi-Purpose Room is used as an Auditorium.
- The School utilizes (1) Lunch Period 11:15 am – 12:05 (50% of the total population is Flipped between eating & play time) to serve the current student population.

Sherman Elementary School (K – 5th Grade)

Sherman School has 18 Classrooms – (3 per grade level) within the School.

1. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that a Kindergarten Classroom be 950 Square Feet including the attached toilet room for 21 students.

The (2) Kindergarten Classrooms are 675 and 831 sf.

2. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 1st thru 3rd Grade Classrooms be 850 Square Feet for 21 students.

The (3) 1st Grade Classrooms are 683, 699 and 719 sf.

The (3) 2nd Grade Classrooms are 693, 719 and 774 sf.

The (3) 3rd Grade Classrooms are 694, 703 and 718 sf.

3. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 4th and 5th Grade Classrooms be 800 Square Feet for 23 students.

The (3) 4th Grade Classrooms are 674, 680 and 686 sf.

The (3) 5th Grade Classrooms are 650, 710 and 995 sf.

- Per the State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) One (1) additional classroom would be needed over the next five years to accommodate the increased 5th Grade student population.
- Art and Music are combined within (1) 1, 146 sf Classroom. An addition to the building would be required if the District would like these separate Art and Music.
- There is one Multi-Purpose Room serving (2) functions – Gym and Auditorium.
- There is a separate Cafeteria at this School. The School utilizes (1) Lunch Period 11:15 am – 12:05 pm (50% of the total population is Flipped between eating & play time) to serve the current student population.

Robert Gordon Elementary School (K – 5th Grade)

Robert Gordon School has 13 Classrooms – (3) for Kindergarten and (2) each for Grades 1 thru 5 within the School.

1. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that a Kindergarten Classroom be 950 Square Feet including the attached toilet room for 21 students.

The (2) Kindergarten Classrooms are 769 and 799 sf.

2. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 1st thru 3rd Grade Classrooms be 850 Square Feet for 21 students.

The (2) 1st Grade Classrooms are 760 and 764 sf.

The (2) 2nd Grade Classrooms are 764 and 776 sf.

The (2) 3rd Grade Classrooms are 750 and 783 sf.

3. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 4th and 5th Grade Classrooms be 800 Square Feet for 23 students.

The (2) 4th Grade Classrooms are 733 and 792 sf.

The (2) 5th Grade Classrooms are 725 and 757 sf.

- Per the State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) no additional classrooms are required to accommodate the small increase in student population.
- Art and Music are combined within (1) 948 sf Classroom. An addition to the building would be required if the District would like these separate Art and Music.
- There is one Multi-Purpose Room serving (2) functions – Gym and Auditorium.
- There is a separate Cafeteria. The School utilizes (2) Lunch Periods (Flipped between eating & play time within an 11:10 am – 12:10 pm start and stop time) to serve the student population.
- The School does not have an elevator for wheelchair access to all floors. An exterior elevator shaft and interior/exterior modifications would be required if the District would like to add an elevator to this School.

Roselle Park Middle School (6th-8th Grade)

Roselle Park Middle School has 20 Classrooms for all three Grades within the School.

1. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 6th thru 8th Grade Classrooms be 800 Square Feet and 23 students.

(2) Classrooms are 646 sf.

(2) Classrooms are 667 sf.

(3) Classrooms are 703 sf.

(1) Classroom is 725 sf.

(3) Classrooms are 736 sf.

(2) Classrooms are 744 sf.

(1) Classrooms are 768 sf.

(4) Classrooms are 899 sf.

(2) Classrooms are 943 sf.

- Per the State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) and at a 90% Utilization Rate - Five (5) additional classrooms will be needed over the next five years to accommodate the increased student population. Three (3) additional classrooms are required at 100% Utilization.
- Art and Music are in separate 1,089 sf and 1,091 sf Classrooms.
- There is a separate Auditorium and Gymnasium with a room divider between each space.
- There is also a separate Cafeteria. The School utilizes (3) Lunch Periods 11:7 am – 1:13 pm start and stop time) to serve the student population. 8th Grade 11:07 am – 11:47 am, 6th Grade 11:50 am – 12:30 pm, 7th Grade 12:33 pm – 1:13 pm.

Roselle Park High School (9th-12th Grade)

Roselle Park High School has 29 Classrooms for all four Grades in the School (Four (4) of these Classrooms are also Science rooms).

1. The State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) recommends that the 9th thru 12th Grade Classrooms be 750 Square Feet for 24 students.

(1) Classroom is 649 sf.

(5) Classrooms are 676 - 687 sf.

(4) Classrooms are 706 - 736 sf.

(3) Classrooms are 749 - 751 sf.

(8) Classroom is 774 - 786 sf.

(1) Classrooms are 938 sf.

(3) Classrooms are 953 sf.

(4) Classrooms are 1,049 -1339 sf (These are also Science Rooms).

- Per the State DOE Facilities Efficiency Standards (F.E.S.) and at an 85% Utilization Rate – One (1) Additional Classrooms will be needed at this School over the next five years to accommodate the increased student population. At 100% utilization rate- No Additional Classroom is needed.
- Art and Music are in separate 1,104 sf and 1,158 sf Classrooms
- There is a separate Auditorium and Gymnasium
- There is also a separate Cafeteria. The School utilizes (3) 40 min. Lunch Periods within an 11:12 am – 1:12 pm start and stop time to serve the student population.
