PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (hereafter, the Commission) considered at its meeting of March 15, 2016, the Complaint for non-filing of 2013 primary election reports in the above-captioned case, issued on May 27, 2015, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq., which Complaint is hereby incorporated by reference in this Final Decision. The Commission considered Respondent's Affidavit and Waiver of Hearing submitted in response to the Complaint, and by a vote of 2-0, adopted as its Final Decision the proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Complaint, after modifying them to reflect that Respondent filed a Candidate – Sworn Statement (Form A-1) for the 2013 primary election on June 4, 2015 (759 days late). In assessing a penalty, the Commission relied upon Respondent's statement that no funds were spent in the 2013 primary election.

PENALTY

THEREFORE, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-22 and N.J.A.C. 19:25-17.1 et seq., the Commission hereby REPRIMANDS the Respondent Candidate and imposes a penalty in the amount of \$275.00 for late filing of Form A-1. Respondent submitted payment of \$275.00. No further payment is required.
